FOREWORD

The subject of Rural Development has been receiving increasing attention over the past several years in the international scene. Resulting from this situation, affluent nations and donor agencies have begun to siphon more and more aid for the amelioration of the rural populations in developing countries. Sri Lanka is a case in point where several integrated rural development programmes are under way with such assistance. In addition to the state supported projects, non-governmental and voluntary organizations have also launched their own programmes with rural poor as the target group.

These activities in Sri Lanka have led to the production of a large volume of literature not only by the agencies involved in such programmes but also by institutions, students and individuals who share an abiding interest in rural development. With the addition of these writings to the already existing works, the vastness of the body of literature on rural development has understandably become daunting to everybody who seeks access to it.

The Agrarian Research and Training Institute whose research interests include the discipline of rural development has been aware of this problem for some time. With a view to helping researchers, planners, policy makers and all others who in the course of their work need to gain access to various documents on the subject, we have attempted as far as possible to bring together in this bibliography some of the more important writings. We hope that this bibliography would prove useful to all those who are looking for this information and we also hope that it would contribute to the production of more documents.

The preparation of this bibliography was originally undertaken at my request by Mr. D. Gamage, Research and Training Officer. On the verge of his proceeding overseas for post-graduate studies, the responsibility was taken over by Mr. Wilfred Ranasinghe, Librarian. He has since compiled it on a much broader base, making it a more resourceful and systematic compilation. Its present size and format are entirely due to Mr. Ranasinghe's efforts.

This bibliography as its title suggests is by no means exhaustive and comprehensive. It is quite possible that certain important and popular items may not have been included. Users of this bibliography are kindly requested to bring any such omissions to our notice.

INTRODUCTION

The rationale for compiling a bibliography of this nature is briefly explained in the 'Foreword'. The purpose of this introduction is mainly to define its scope, arrangement and limitations.

This bibliography lists books, monographs, articles in periodicals, research papers (mostly mimeographed), and unpublished theses and reports. Relevant chapters from books are also included. Newspaper articles are excluded. English is the language of the material included here except for a few items in Sinhala.

Due to certain reasons, particularly the need to be selective, easy access to material was the main criterion used for selection. Thus the bulk of the items included in this bibliography forms part of the holdings of the ARTI library. In the process of selection no attempt was however made to be time specific, i.e. the material included is not confined to any particular period of time. Within the declared scope and limitations of this exercise, the bibliography is intended, in the main, to serve the research interests of ARTI staff and those who use its Library.

The plan of classification used in this compilation was specially devised in consultation with several researchers of ARTI. Entries within each section (and sub-section) are arranged alphabetically by personal or corporate author, with a few anonymous items arranged by title. The bibliographic form adopted is in accordance with normal cataloguing practice (AACR 1967 ed.) except for one or two minor modifications. Official publications of institutions, ministries, government departments and so on have been entered under the official body as most researchers tend to prefer the 'official agency' approach. However, personal authorship is indicated in the body of the entry, wherever applicable, and is also reflected in the author index. Forms of names as found on title pages have been taken for author headings. In the case of names involving more than one form, the most widely used form has been selected. Full description of an item occurs in one place only with secondary interests indicated by means of unnumbered cross references. Annotations are given in respect of certain entries where clarity was thought to be necessary.

The author index is in two parts. The first part consists of personal names, while names of corporate authors make up the second part. Numbers indicated against authors' names, both personal and corporate, refer to the serial numbering of the entries. Nineteen items which escaped inclusion in the main text are separately listed in alphabetical order as an Addendum. They are also not reflected in the author index.

It is a source of pleasure to acknowledge the assistance rendered by the library staff in this exercise. I owe a special word of thanks to Miss Kamani Paranawithana, Steno/Typist, who was responsible for the typing of the entire manuscript.
